While it is unconfirmed whether the tees were a direct nod to the film's plot, fans believe that they were hinting at a tussle between Janhvi Kapoor and Sanya Malhotra's characters. Touted to be a complete family entertainer, the film is set to release on October 2, 2025, coinciding with Dussehra.

According to a report in Bollywood Hungama, producer Karan Johar and the team strategically chose the October 2 release date to capitalise on the festive window. A source revealed, "Producer Karan Johar and the whole team realised that this is the apt time to bring this rom-com. This year, besides Gandhi Jayanti, Dussehra also falls on the same day. Hence, it'll be a festive period and hopefully, it will face no other competition until Diwali. In other words, it will have a clean run for three weeks."

However, the rom-com won't have a completely solo release. With its new date, Sunny Sanskari Ki Tulsi Kumari is set for a box office clash with Kantara: A Legend – Chapter 1 and the Harshvardhan Rane-starrer Ek Deewane Ki Deewaniyat.
