

Yami Gautam On 'Massive Shift' In Bollywood After Dhurandhar: 'We Were Struggling To Get People Into Theatres'



Yami Gautam has spoken about how there has been a massive shift in Bollywood after the success of her husband, Aditya Dhar's Dhurandhar franchise. She mentioned that films have always been a director's medium, and Dhurandhar's success proves that the audience is ready to return to theatres if the basics of the films are sorted. She said that now, the industry is on a 'growth curve'.

Yami Gautam told Grazia, "This is why I said it was always a director's medium – it was always script and all

those basic things that make a film, a film. The basics are back, so that's a massive shift. It's not just about a film doing well and new box office records."

he explained, "I don't think Dhurandhar's success is telling us only that. We were struggling to get people into theatres, and we were figuring and toying around with things. But people thronging theatres tells you – we are ready, we want you to make amazing films, we'll watch, and yes, we'll come repeatedly."

In the same chat, Yami also spoke about whether the success of Dhurandhar has changed Aditya or her attitude. Yami Gautam said, "Nothing has changed us as people. That also comes from Aditya, and the kind of person he is, very unaffected and extremely humble. I've seen him through different phases."

"There are highs and lows and vulnerable phases, but it's not like during that phase we expressed our frustration or let it out. Both of us are extremely

thankful to God, for us spirituality is very important, we believe in the Almighty. Good things happen to good people. What's meant for you may be delayed but never denied," the actress concluded.

Meanwhile, Yami Gautam is set to headline a horror-comedy titled Nayyi Navelli. The film promises to offer audiences a refreshing cinematic experience when it hits theatres. However, it was also announced that after its theatrical run, the film will premiere on Prime Video.

She said, "Physically, I was in a lot of pain, which I don't think happens to everybody, but I was in a lot of pain. I couldn't stand straight because it just felt like there was a big balloon inside me, and my doctor was like maybe because you're just really small. So, I couldn't stand straight, and I used to go to my sister's house. So, I live in the B wing, and she lives in the A wing. So, I would walk to her house for her to inject me, and for 2 or 3 days, I couldn't even walk as I was in so much pain. I couldn't stand it."

Akansha revealed that when she asked the doctor what workout she could do, she was told she could only walk.

"After the first day, there's no way I can even walk. So, that was a lot. And I did not expect to feel so physically blah. It's not a period cramp. It's not pain. It's just a discomfort, which is bloating, heavy-



ness, like there's just a big balloon in my stomach and it'll burst any minute. So, I need to be like this, and also the hormones."
